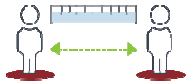


RULES AND GOOD PRACTICE FOR THE EXHIBITOR ABOUT COVID 19



Inside the exhibition center, it is always mandatory to wear a surgical or FFP2 mask



Design the stands of suitable dimensions. Organize the spaces in order not to create gatherings.



Avoid contacts between visitors as much as possible. Design the stand, if possible, with separate entrance and exit.



Inside the exhibition center it is guaranteed adequate ventilation with continuous air exchange without recirculation. Avoid stands that are too closed.



Respect the hygienic rules issued by competent authorities, including frequent disinfectant hand sanitization. Place an appropriate number of dispensers inside the stand.



Always remind visitors of the importance of respecting rules. Staff in charge at the stand must be adequately trained. Use informative graphic!



Organize meetings and presentations taking adequate distance between people.



There are no special requirements on the materials to be used for set-up. However, it is suggested to prefer those easily washable.



Keep your stand always in good hygienic condition. Intensify cleaning operations when you receive many visitors.



Follow the current regulations concerning Catering Services . **Do not provide buffet and self service!**



Use self service mode for the distribution of gadgets and commercial material.



Use computer systems to manage visits to the stand. Schedule appointments and avoid creating gatherings at the entrances.



Inside the exhibition center it is always guaranteed the presence of a doctor and medical staff equipped with the appropriate DPI "Covid-19" and the necessary equipment and spaces. If you're having trouble, call the internal emergency numbers.
